ORDINANCE 2024 – 16

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH VALOR OUTFITTERS FOR THE REMOVAL, TRANSFER, PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF EMERGENCY EQUIPMENT INTO FIVE (5) NEW POLICE VEHICLES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$116,325

WHEREAS, The City wishes to remove, transfer, purchase and install new emergency equipment into five (5) new police vehicles; and

WHEREAS, City staff has obtained quotes for this equipment and services; and NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the City of Mason accepts the quote provided by Valor Outfitters and agrees that Valor Outfitters is the best bidder.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Valor Outfitters. for the removal, transfer, purchase and installation of emergency equipment into five (5) new police vehicles in the amount of \$116,325.

<u>Section 3.</u> That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Valor Outfitters the total sum of \$116,325 for said services and equipment.

<u>Section 4.</u> That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
