

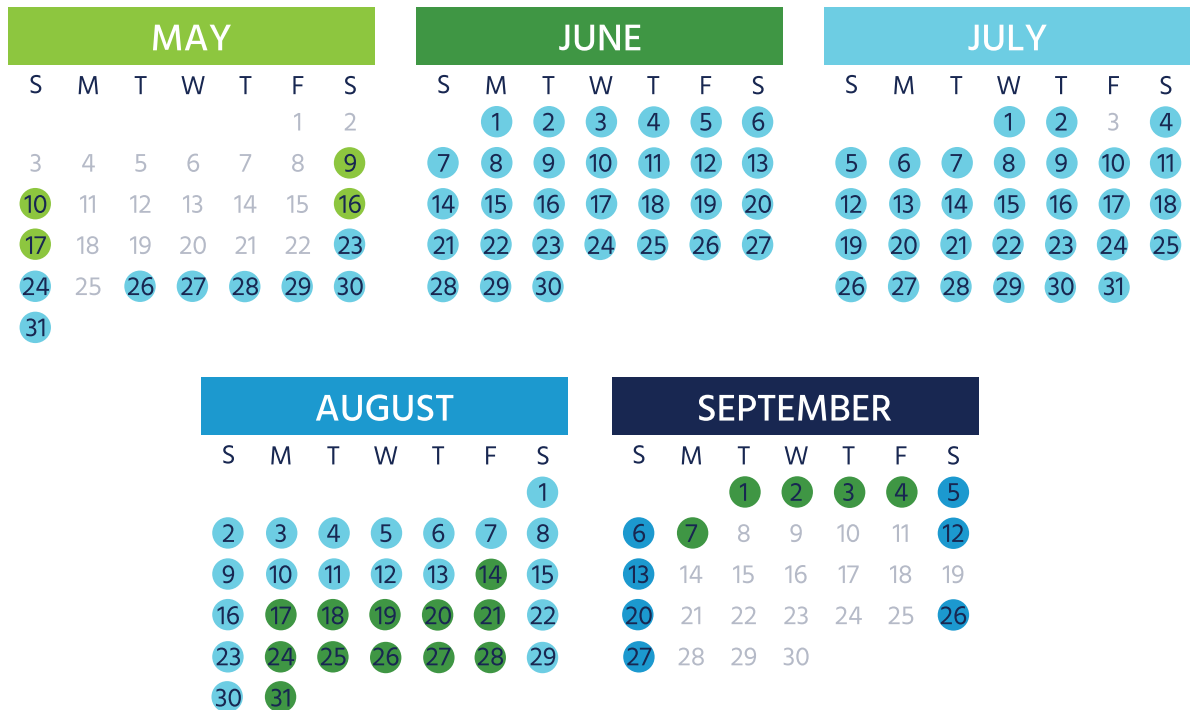

# POOL SAFETY GUIDELINES

**Welcome to the Mason Municipal Aquatic Center! Thank you for adhering to these guidelines and helping create a family-friendly environment for everyone to enjoy.**

## **CONCESSIONS**

The City of Mason contracts with a local food service provider to provide concessions for patrons of the Aquatic Center. Patronage of the concessions is encouraged for the sustainability of this service. Thank you for your continued support of our local business community.

## **OUTSIDE FOOD AND BEVERAGE**

We understand concessions offered might not be suitable for some of our patrons due to age or allergies. Guests are permitted small coolers. For the safety of our patrons, no glass or alcohol is permitted. Outside food deliveries compete with the concession services and are not permitted.

## **WATER SLIDES AND INFLATABLE OBSTACLE COURSE (WIBIT)**

For your child's safety, please note that guests 48" or taller may enjoy the water slides. Guests 6 years of age, at least 48" tall and able to swim 25 meters without stopping in the presence of a lifeguard may enjoy the obstacle course. Guests must complete a waiver before participation (completed upon entrance to the facility).

## **LIFEGUARDS**

Lifeguards are required to be on deck at all times that the pool is open. Lifeguards are not permitted to engage in casual conversations while they are on duty. For non-emergency questions or concerns, please visit City of Mason staff at the check-in window.

## **REST PERIOD**

A rest period is conducted for safety and health reasons the last ten minutes of each hour. Swimmers, especially young swimmers, need a break to hydrate, regulate body temperature and rest, reducing the risk of becoming too tired to swim or experiencing muscle cramps in the water. Lifeguards use these breaks to reset their focus, check water conditions, and ensure that the pool remains a safe environment for all to enjoy.

## **INFANTS AND SMALL CHILDREN**

Please be mindful of small children swimming near you. Notify a lifeguard immediately if you see a child left alone, in need or struggling. Children under 12 years of age must be accompanied by a responsible adult or caregiver. Children 4 years of age and under must be within arms reach of their responsible adult or caregiver.

## **FLOATATION DEVICES AND POOL TOYS**

U.S. Coast Guard approved life-saving flotation devices are required. Pool toys are fun, but they can make it challenging for lifeguards to safely monitor all guests. Pool toys may not be permitted on busy days or designated times as when they may create an unsafe situation. Patrons are encouraged to check with pool staff before taking toys into the water.

## **ALCOHOL AND SMOKING/VAPING**

Thank you for helping build a culture of wellness at the Aquatic Center. The Aquatic Center is an alcohol and smoke/vape free facility.
