General Statement of Duties and Distinguishing Features of Class

Performs manual labor of more than ordinary difficulty that often involves the use of acquired skill; does related work as required. This work calls for the use of some skills acquired by experience or on-the-job instruction. Requires more than usual physical strength and endurance. A maintenance worker normally works under the supervision of Maintenance Supervisor. Employee is required to be able to complete tasks with limited supervision. Employees in this class may be assisted by one or more maintenance workers.

Examples of Work (Illustrative Only)

- Performs a variety of semi-skilled building and ground maintenance and painting tasks;
- Assists in the operations and maintenance of Parks & Recreation, Public Utilities, or Public Works properties and others as assigned;
- Handles and uses hand tools and power tools including chain saw and gas-powered weed eater;
- Fells trees, cuts them up, and drags the pieces to a brush chipper. Loads pieces into brush chipper or onto truck;
- Performs litter control;
- Drives trucks or car to obtain supplies and samples;
- Drives light tractors and mowing equipment.

Skills, Knowledge, and Abilities: The following is preferred

- High School diploma or its equivalent;
- Possess a valid Ohio Driver's License and have maintained a good driving record;
- Some knowledge of a variety of semi-skilled maintenance and manual tasks;
- Ability to understand and follow oral and written instructions;
- Ability to read and write legibly;
- Ability to perform heavy manual work for an extended period under varying climate conditions;
- Available for scheduled and emergency overtime;
- Ability to complete tasks with limited supervision;
- Must be able to work eight consecutive hours in changing outdoor conditions. Exposed to dust, pollen, and fumes associated with outdoor labor.

Physical Requirements:

- Excellent physical condition – able to bend, lift objects of 70 lbs. or greater routinely;
- Visual acuity to distinguish from short and long distances;
- Auditory acuity to hear the radio or communication from fair distances;
- Manual dexterity to operate equipment, manipulate small objects;
- Able to operate efficiently in dramatic climates.
