ORDINANCE 2016 - 121

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH CENTURY EQUIPMENT CO. FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) TORO MULTI-PRO 1750 SPRAYER, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$32,487.77, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio has advertised and received bids for the purchase of

equipment under the State Bid Program; and

WHEREAS, Century Equipment Co. was the best bidder with a bid of \$32,487.77 for

the purchase of one (1) Toro Multi-Pro 1750 Sprayer for use by the city.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio,

seven members elected thereto concurring:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the City of Mason accepts the State's equipment specifications and agrees that Century Equipment Co. is the best bidder.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Century Equipment Co. for the purchase on one (1) Toro Multi-Pro 1750 Sprayer.

<u>Section 3.</u> That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Century Equipment the sum of \$32,487.77 for said sprayer.

<u>Section 4.</u> That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The need for said emergency is to be able to purchase the mower at 2016 contract prices.
