

**ORDINANCE 2017 - 10**

**AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH JACK DOHENY SUPPLY FOR THE PURCHASE OF ACOUSTIC SEWER INSPECTION EQUIPMENT**

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has a need for acoustic sewer inspection equipment to assist with inspecting the City's sanitary and storm sewer collection systems; and

WHEREAS, bids have been sought and obtained for the purchase of said equipment through the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program; and

WHEREAS, Jack Doheny Supply was the lowest and best bidder for the purchase of an SL-RAT Acoustic Inspection Equipment Unit with the bid price of \$22,600.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City of Mason agrees that the bid of Jack Doheny Supply is equal to or less than the best bidder.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Jack Doheny Supply in an amount not to exceed \$22,600 pursuant to the terms of the proposal attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Jack Doheny Supply the amount not to exceed \$22,600 for the purchase of said equipment.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall be effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
