

ORDINANCE 2017 – 27

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH RACK & BALLAUER EXCAVATING CO., INC. FOR THE MASON-MONTGOMERY / BETHANY BIKE PATH PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$562,217

WHEREAS, the City of Mason received on February 21, 2017, a total of six (6) competitive bids for the construction of Mason Montgomery/Bethany Bike Path Project; and

WHEREAS, Rack & Ballauer Excavating Co. Inc., was the lowest and best bidder with a total bid (Base bid plus Alternate 1 and Alternate 2) of \$562,217 for the Mason Montgomery/Bethany Bike Path Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the total bid of Rack & Ballauer Excavating Co. Inc., in the amount of \$562,217, is hereby accepted as the lowest and best bid for the Mason Montgomery/Bethany Bike Path Project.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Rack & Ballauer Excavating Co., Inc., for the Mason Montgomery/Bethany Bike Path Project according to the specifications set forth by the City.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Rack & Ballauer Excavating Co., Inc., an amount not to exceed \$562,217 for the Mason Montgomery/Bethany Bike Path Project.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
