

**ORDINANCE 2017 – 59**

**AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THORGUARD WEATHER IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$38,640 FOR THE PURCHASE OF A LIGHTNING PREDICTION SYSTEM**

WHEREAS, the City has previously partnered with Mason youth sports organizations to acquire a lightning detection system for Sundin Fields at Heritage Oak Park; and

WHEREAS, the City now desires to add additional lightning prediction systems in other City parks and the Municipal Center campus.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, \_\_\_\_\_ members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with ThorGuard Weather for the purchase of a lightning prediction system, at a cost not to exceed \$38,640, substantially in the form of the contract attached hereto as Exhibit A, incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay ThorGuard Weather an amount not to exceed \$38,640, pursuant to the terms of the contract.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
