

ORDINANCE NO. 2014 - 105

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH HENRY P. THOMPSON COMPANY FOR TWO (2) REPLACEMENT PUMPS, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$60,000.00, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Mason, during annual preventive maintenance on the Arbor Creek lift station, discovered the pumps are not working properly; and

WHEREAS, it is imperative that the replacement to the pumps be completed at the earliest possible time in order to protect public health; and

WHEREAS, Henry P. Thompson Company was contacted by City staff and asked to furnish prices for the two (2) replacement pumps on an emergency basis; and

WHEREAS, Henry P. Thompson Company can provided the two (2) replacement pumps for an amount not to exceed of \$60,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, five members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That Council finds it acceptable, in accordance with information supplied in advance of the furnishing by Henry P. Thompson Company of the two (2) replacement pumps, to proceed with said work in an amount not to exceed \$60,000.00.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a purchase agreement with Henry P. Thompson Company for the emergency replacement pumps.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is authorized to pay Henry P. Thompson Company an amount not to exceed \$60,000.00 upon execution of a purchase agreement between the City of Mason and Henry P. Thompson Company.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to execute the contract at the earliest possible date.
