

ORDINANCE NO. 2015 - 62

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH GLOCKNER OIL COMPANY FOR THE PURCHASE OF BULK LUBRICANT TANKS AND DISPENSING EQUIPMENT FOR THE MASON SERVICE CENTER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$28,418, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, bids were solicited for the bulk lubricant tanks and dispensing equipment for the Mason Service Center; and

WHEREAS, Glockner Oil Company was the best bidder with a bid of \$28,418.00 for the purchase and installation of all necessary tanks and dispensing equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Glockner Oil Company for the purchase and installation of all necessary tanks and dispensing equipment for the Mason Service Center.

Section 2. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Glockner Oil Company the total sum of \$28,418.00 for said lubricant tanks and dispensing equipment.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The need for said emergency is the necessity to provide and install the equipment as soon as possible to allow for vehicle maintenance operations to begin at the new service center.
