ORDINANCE 2016 - 50

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH GREATER CINCINNATI WATER WORKS (GCWW) FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF RESURFACING WORK IN THE AMOUNT OF \$50,000

WHEREAS, GCWW's contractor is required to resurface half of Cherokee Drive and Apache Lane to restore the areas impacted by water main construction, and

WHEREAS, the City of Mason would like to concurrently resurface the other half of the roadways, and

WHEREAS, GCWW has submitted their reimbursement costs for said resurfacing work completed by their contractor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with GCWW, for reimbursement of resurfacing work completed by their contractor.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to reimburse GCWW, an amount not to exceed \$50,000.

<u>Section 3.</u> That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
