I understand and agree to the following Mason Community Garden Guidelines and Rules:

- The Mason Community Garden will be available May 12 through October 31.
- Plots will be 10 feet by 15 feet and will initially be plowed by the City of Mason. Any further tilling is the responsibility of the plot applicant.
- Plots are provided for the use of the applicant and do not imply any transfer of ownership of the plot to the applicant.
- Only one plot will be assigned to any individual, family, or organization before May 12. After that date, additional plots may be assigned as available.
- Plots are located on the west side of Mason-Morrow-Millgrove Road, across from Mason Sports Park.
- I will have something planted in the garden by May 30 and keep it planted all summer long.
- If I must abandon my plot for any reason, I will notify the Community Garden Coordinator.
- I will keep weeds at a minimum and maintain the pathways immediately surrounding my plot.
- If my plot becomes unkempt, I understand I will be given one week's notice to clean it up. At that time, it will be re-assigned or tilled in.
- I will keep trash and litter out of the plot, as well as from adjacent pathways and fences.
- I will plant tall crops where they will not shade neighboring plots.
- I will pick only my own crops unless given permission by another plot user.
- I will not use fertilizers, insecticides, or weed repellents that will in any way affect other plots.
- I will not use synthetic or manmade weed barriers. Straw, mulch and paper are permitted and encouraged
- I will not bring pets to the garden.
- I understand and agree that the City of Mason and the Mason Community Garden are not responsible for any damage or injury resulting from the use of this property. I will hold the City of Mason and the Mason Community Garden volunteers harmless from any liability or claims arising from the use of this property.
