

Participant Guidelines

Please review the below guidelines carefully to understand participant's expectations and guarantee a positive experience in this event.

- Artwork submitted will be on display throughout various business locations in the Mason Mile on October 21st, 2023 from 3:00 - 7:00pm. The public is invited to visit participating Mason Mile businesses to view the artwork, helping to promote those businesses.
- We encourage artists and participants to explore the Mason Mile! Artists will intentionally not be given the location of their artwork along the Mason Mile to encourage the exploration of the Mason Mile and view all artists' submissions.
- Art submission should be related to locations, objects or activities that take place or are located within the City of Mason limits. Questions on whether your favorite place is located in the City of Mason? Please email pegelfers@gmail.com for clarification.
- An 8"x10" canvas will be provided at no cost to participants. One canvas or entry is allowed per participant.
- All submission must use 8"x10" stretched canvas as provided.
- Participants are asked to provide name, address, email and phone number at the time canvas is picked up.
- Participants may draw, paint, or use the visual art form of your preference.
- All submissions must be family-friendly. All submissions will be reviewed prior to placement. Event organizers reserve the right disregard any artwork that is not family-friendly in nature or depict a location or event that is not located in the City of Mason corporate limits.
- Submissions are due no later than Friday, October 6 at 12:00 p.m. Submission received after that day and time will not be included as part of this event.
- Upon collection of the Art by the City of Mason, the City shall not be responsible for any damage of any sort to the Art while it is being displayed or until such time as it is picked up by Artist.
- Upon completion of the program, the City may elect to keep any Art, and use such Art, at its sole discretion. The City will contact the Artist, should the City decide to keep such Art. Artist shall have from October 25th until October 30th to pick up the Art. Failure to do so by the deadline shall relinquish all rights of Artist to the rights of the Art. After the deadline, the City may elect to keep any Art or dispose of it as the City determines, at its sole discretion.
